**Rappahannock County Government Offices  
Modify Hours and Operations**

*Critical Services Remain Available to Citizens by Phone and Email*

(Washington, VA) – Even though there continue to be no known cases of COVID-19 in Rappahannock County, to protect the health of county citizens and employees, and while continuing to provide critical services, Rappahannock County government offices will modify hours and operations effective today.

We ask the public to conduct county-government business by telephone or email whenever possible and until further notice. The following describes changes made in each county office. These practices are subject to change over the coming days and weeks as we adapt to the evolving COVID-19 situation.

**County Administration: 675-5330**

- Please conduct business by telephone or email when possible.
- Appointment required if a meeting is necessary.

**Building Official / Zoning Administrator / Emergency Services / 911 Coordination: 675-5340**

- Closed to the public.
- A pick-up/drop-off location is in place in the corridor outside of the office.
- Building permit inspections will continue, but must be arranged by telephone/email.
- When necessary, meetings will be scheduled by appointment only for time-sensitive matters.

**Social Services: 675-3313**

- Closed to the public.
- Process in place to use mail, email, and telephone to discuss benefits and services.
- The public can use [commonhelp.virginia.gov](http://commonhelp.virginia.gov) or call (855) 635-4370 to access benefit programs.

**Refuse and Recycling Centers:**

- Hours of operations are unchanged, but attendants have been instructed to keep a proper distance.
- Please observe appropriate social distancing when using the Amissville or Flatwood center. After disposing your waste, please leave the center rather than remain for a social visit with staff or neighbors.

**Visitors Center:**

- Closed to the public
- Public Wi-Fi available in the parking area.
