Alkaline Batteries SEE ATTENDANT!

Anti-Freeze Ethylene glycol and propylene glycol fluids accepted only
NOT ACCEPTED: Flush water or oil

Appliances Non freon-bearing in the metal recycle bin (see **White Goods** for freon-bearing)

Cardboard Please flatten - No trash or bags

Electronic Items - Rappahannock County Residents Only

We will accept no more than one (1) console or cabinet-type TV per month per family. TVs may be brought to Flatwood. Computer monitors are limited to two per month - no charge

Engines & Parts Engine blocks and parts must be free of any oil or fluid residue before placing in metal recycle bin - no charge

Fluorescent Bulbs All fluorescent bulbs are recycled - **Do not break**

Gas & Fuel Oil Tanks All tanks must have both ends cut off and cleaned of any residue before being deposited in metal recycle bin - no charge

Glass Bottles, Jars, Plastics, Aluminum, Steel and Tin Cans Recycled together in one container

Plastics #1, #2, #3, #4, #5, #6, #7 accepted

NOT ACCEPTED: plate and tempered glass, mirrors, light bulbs, ceramics, chemical bottles, foil, trays, pots, pans, aerosol cans, paint cans, plastic bags

Lawn Mowers Batteries, oil, and gas must be removed from engine before depositing in metal recycle bin - no charge

Lead-Acid Batteries (typically cars & trucks) All lead-acid batteries accepted SEE ATTENDANT!

Metal - (including small amounts of fencing wire, paint cans and tin buckets if completely empty)

NOT ACCEPTED: ashes, propane, acetylene, oxygen tanks, drums, tires, trash, aluminum, tin cans, computers, monitors, TVs, nails, lumber, plastics, large amounts of fencing wire.

Oil-Filters A receptacle next to the oil recycling is provided for all used oil filters accepted

Newspapers & Magazines All newspapers, magazines, paperback books, and loose paper accepted. Do not leave strings, plastic bags, or cardboard boxes.

NOT ACCEPTED: hard-bound books, cereal boxes, paper towel rolls

Rechargeable Batteries Nickel cadmium (Ni-Cd), nickel metal hydride (Ni-MH), lithium ion (Li-ion), small sealed lead (Pb) weighing less than 2 lbs accepted (these are common in cell phones, cordless phones, radio control cars and trucks, and Power Wheels)



Used Oils engine oil, transmission fluid, power steering fluid, diesel fuel, gear oil, turbine engine oil, hydraulic oil, fuel oil #2, #4, and #6 accepted

NOT ACCEPTED: chlorinated solvents, water, transformer oil, refrigeration oil, parts cleaning solvents, anti-freeze, fiberglass resin, gasoline, paints and thinners, any flammable liquids, metal-working fluids, brake fluid and cleaner, carb cleaner, freon, radiator flush, ice melt, Naphtha

Give Away Shed: There is an area where you may drop off things you no longer want (such as clothing, books, shoes, toys, etc). These items must be in good shape and re-useable. Flatwood does not accept large or bulky items, except at the discretion of the attendant on duty.

Brush, Tree Clippings, Stumps Etc. ⊘ (up to 6" diameter) SEE ATTENDANT!

Pick-up load or less per week - First 500 lbs at no charge

Drum-type Containers All metal drums must have the top and bottom cut off, and be cleaned of any residue before being accepted - no charge

Propane Tanks ⊘ (grill size)

\$ 2.00 SEE ATTENDANT!

WHOLE Tires ⊘

Autos/Pick-Ups/ATVs/Cycles/Large Lawn Mowers

Must be less than 26" high \$ 4.00

Tires on Rims (< 26" high) \$ 4.50

Trucks

Must be less than 36" high \$ 6.00

Tires on Rims (<36" high) \$ 6.50

Tractors or Large Truck

Must be less than 46" high \$11.00

Tires on Rim (<46" high) \$11.50
