

Recycling

Recycling conserves natural resources and reduces pollution. Recycling also greatly saves landfill space. Take the time to Recycle today.

Glass. Bottles and Jars. Green, Brown and Clear are accepted. Not accepted: Plate & Tempered glass, Mirrors, Light Bulbs, Ceramics, or Chemical Bottles.

Aluminum, Steel, & Tin Cans. Items not accepted: Foil, Trays, Pots & Pans, Aerosol Cans, Paint cans.

Plastics #1 & #2 Only #1 & #2 accepted. We do not accept other numbers. If plastic is not marked with a number, do not throw these items in recycle bin.

Newspapers & Magazines All Newspapers, Magazines, and Loose Paper accepted. Do Not leave behind Strings, Plastic Bags, or Cardboard Boxes. Items not accepted: Books, Junk Mail, Cereal type boxes, Paper Towel type rolls.

All Rechargeable Batteries Nickel Cadmium (Ni-Cd), Nickel Metal Hydride (Ni-MH), Lithium Ion (Li-ion), Small Sealed Lead (Pb) (weighing less than 2 lbs). These are common in Cell Phones, Cordless Phones, Radio Control Cars & Trucks, and Power Wheels.

Alkaline Batteries Give Attendant these batteries.

Lead-Acid Batteries All lead-acid batteries.

Used Oils. Engine Oil, Transmission Fluid, Power Steering Fluid, Diesel Fuel, Gear Oil, Turbine Engine Oil, Hydraulic Oil, Fuel Oil #2 #4 #6. **WE DO NOT ACCEPT IN OIL DRUM:** Chlorinated Solvents, Water, Transformer Oil, Refrigeration Oil, Parts Cleaning Solvents, Anti-Freeze, Fiberglass Resin, Gasoline, Paints and Thinners, Any Flammable Liquids, Metal Working Fluids, Brake Fluid & Cleaner, Carb Cleaner, Freon, Radiator Flush, Ice Melters, Naphtha.

Oil-Filters. A receptacle next to the Oil recycling is provided for All Used Oil Filters.

Anti-Freeze. Ethylene Glycol and Propylene Glycol fluids only. No Flush Water or Oil is accepted in Used Anti-Freeze Drum.

Fluorescent Bulbs. All Fluorescent Bulbs are recycled. Do Not break them prior to bringing them in. See Attendant.

Too Good To Waste Area. There is an area where you may drop off things you no longer want. These items must be in good shape and not wore out. **FLATWOOD** will not accept large or bulky items (Furniture, etc).

Electronics. The County has begun recycling most all electronic goods. If you are throwing out anything electronic, please ask Attendant before throwing in dumpster.

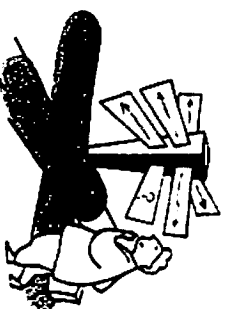

Asbestos is common in many older homes, in walls, paints, flooring, insulation, and appliances. There is no way to tell if the material contains asbestos without it being tested in a lab. We can no longer accept materials containing asbestos.

Waste NOT accepted

Improper disposal of hazardous materials, pollute the environment and cause possible injury to landfill workers. Please dispose of your hazardous items in the proper way. DO NOT hide these items in bags and throw in dumpster. See Attendant if you have any of the following items.

The following items are illegal to throw away
See Attendant if you have any of the following:

Ammunition	Radioactive Items
Fireworks	Compressed Gas Cylinders
Explosives	Medical or Infectious Waste

Do Not Hesitate to ask attendant any questions concerning any of the above items. It's better to ask, and be Safe, than not ask, and be Sorry!! – Do Not throw these items in with your regular trash. If we find any of these items in your regular trash, you will be contacted, and legal action may be taken.

METAL ITEMS

Please see attendant before dumping any metal items.

NOTICE: This area is closed at dark, no exceptions.

Drums: All drums must have the top and bottom cut off, and be cleaned of any residue before they are accepted.

Gas & Fuel Oil Tanks: All tanks must have both ends cut off and clean of residue, before being accepted.

Lawn Mowers: Batteries, Oil, and Gas must be removed from engine before depositing in metal pile.

Engines & Parts: Engine blocks and parts must be free of any oil or fluid residue before depositing in metal pile.

Vehicles: Gas Tanks & Tires must be removed. All fluids, to include: Brake Fluid, Transmission Fluid, Gear Oil, Anti-Freeze, Windshield Fluid, Motor Oil, Power Steering Fluid.

Not Accepted in Metal Pile

Appliances, Ashes, Propane, Acetylene, & Oxygen Tanks, Drums, Tires, Trash, Aluminum & Tin Cans, Paint Cans, Tin Buckets, Computers, Monitors, TVs, Nails, Lumber, Plastics, Fencing Wire.
